WORLD BANK STUDY

Can determine country status by new business entry density (new corporation per 1,000 working people aged 15-64)

Study shows Jamaica has density of 1 company for 1,000 companies formed in 2014 i.e. 1775 new companies

Compares to Australia with a density of 14

Developed countries usually have density in double digits
